



TRAVEL AND TOURISM DEPARTMENT

The department currently offers courses in Travel and Tourism at Applied A level and GCSE double award.

Travel and Tourism is a popular and successful subject and has consistently achieved Grade 1 department status. There are currently 4 first year AS Level students, 3 second year A-Level students and a GCSE double award teaching group.

Next year the department is planning to deliver the BTEC programme for all year 1 students and due to this expansion of the programme we are looking to recruit a part time teacher with experience in this area.

Four members of staff contribute to the work of the Department and do teach Business Studies. The areas work closely together and most tutors have been involved in more than one area.

Generally, teaching groups are about 24 in size and are accommodated in the well-presented accommodation. All rooms will have computer terminals connected to the College Network together with interactive whiteboards, and projectors for DVD and internet work.

All members of the Department work as a team to provide the best learning environment for the students. Emphasis is placed on staff supporting each other and sharing good working practice. This takes place informally and more formally in the context of implementing consistent Departmental practice.
